Seminar Hour: Each Thursday 9:45 – 11:25 Credit Hours: 0.50 credit hours/semester

Seminar Mission Statement: The Renaissance High School Seminar program supports the personal, social and academic progress of each student, while developing a sense of community.

Course Objectives:

Students will be able to:

- Build Study Skills
- Receive additional academic Enrichment
- Develop Social Emotional Skills while Building Relationships
- Have Additional Time in School to Work on Academic Assignments
- Make up Quizzes or Exams Missed

Student Expectations

- Students must report to assigned seminar for attendance.
- Students must set and upload goals for each seminar period and plans to achieve the goals on a weekly basis prior to seminar class.
- Students must be actively engaged throughout the entire seminar period. Students who do not have assigned work should be studying, reading, or working independently.
- Students may only check out for one class and must remain in that class for the remainder of the period.
- Travel can only occur during the first 10 mins of seminar. All students should be in a class by 9:45am.
- Students must receive written permission from receiving teacher and have submitted goals prior to seminar period in order to travel.

Attendance:

• Students are expected to attend assigned seminar each session. Students that are absent are required to let their teacher from their assigned seminar know in order to get their absence excused. Students with 3 or more unexcused absences will not be allowed to check out of seminar for the remaining of that quarter.

Teacher Will:

- Sign passport sheets for receiving students by end of day each Wednesday prior to Seminars.
- Record receipt of student goal sheets in MiStar weekly.

Course Evaluation

• Students will be graded on a Pass/Fail basis. Grades are based on the number of goal sheets submitted to their seminar teacher.
